## Heart Bear Crochet Heart Dress with Heart Head Band

**Materials:** double knitting yarn approx. 28-30g in MC

3 x approx. 3-5g in each CC1, CC2, CC3

**Needles:** one 4.5mm crochet hook

**Notions:** sharp darning needle, one 15mm button

**Sizing:** Fits teddy with a waist of around 28cms

#### Note:

Dress is crocheted from hem to neck, starting at the centre back

 Skirt is crocheted-in-the-round, and after decreasing the Bodice is worked back and forth


Bodice has an opening in the centre back complete with a button and loop closure

#### Abbreviations and stitches used in this pattern:

#### Skirt



With MC loosely crochet 70 chain sts. Join in the round with a slip st taking care not to twist the chain.



Rnd 1 - ch 3, dc into next 69 sts, sl st into  $3^{\text{rd}}$  ch st to complete the round.

#### **First Heart Round**

Join CC1

Rnd 2 – ch 3, pc\* into sl st, [ch 3, pc into 7<sup>th</sup> dc, ch 2, pc into 7<sup>th</sup> st again] repeat 8 times, ch 3, pc into first sl st of round, ch 2, sl st into third ch st to complete the round. Cut CC1 leaving short tail.









\*First pc st is half of the heart stitch and the 3ch is the first of the 3 dc in the pc st. See heart stitch chart for more details.











Rnd 3 – with MC sc into 2 ch gap [ch 2, dc into 3<sup>rd</sup> dc, being sure to go over the CC1 3 ch, dc into 4<sup>th</sup> dc, ch 2, sc into 2 ch gap] repeat 9 times, replace last sc with a sl st into the first sc.



Rnd 4 – with MC ch 3, [2 dc into the first 2 ch gap, dc into the 1<sup>st</sup> dc, dc into the 2<sup>nd</sup> dc, 2 dc into the second 2 ch gap, dc into the sc] repeat 9 times, replace last dc with a sl st into third ch st to complete the round



**Second Heart Round**Join CC2

Rnds 5 to 7 – repeat Rnds 2 to 4 with CC2 and MC



Third Heart Round
Join CC3
Rnds 8 to 10 – repeat Rnds 2 to
4 with CC3 and MC



The dress is now completed using the MC only.



Decrease Round for Bodice Rnd 11 – ch 1 [sc3tog into next 3 sts] repeat 22 times, sc in last st, sl st to first ch



*Note* – round should now have only 25 sts.




**Bodice**Row 12 (RS) – ch 1, sc into next 25 sts

Now begin working back and forth.

Row 13 (WS) – turn, ch 1, sc into next 25 sts







Make Armholes for Sleeves Row 14 (RS) – turn, ch 1, sc into next 5 sts, ch 14, skip 2 sts, sc into next 11 sts, ch 14, skip 2 sts, sc into last 5 sts

Row 15 (WS) – turn, ch 1, sc into next 49 sts



Begin Yoke Shaping
Row 16 (RS) – turn, ch 1, sc in
5 sts, sc3tog in 3 sts, sc in 8 sts,
sc3tog in 3 sts, sc in 11 sts,
sc3tog in 3 sts, sc in 8 sts,
sc3tog in 3 sts, sc in last 5 sts

Row 17 (WS) – turn, ch 1, sc into next 41 sts

*Note* – all Wrong Side (WS) rows have no decreases.

Row 18 (RS) – turn, ch 1, sc in 4 sts, sc3tog in 3 sts, sc in 6 sts, sc3tog in 3 sts, sc in 9 sts, sc3tog in 3 sts, sc in 6 sts, sc3tog in 3 sts, sc in 6 sts, sc3tog in 3 sts, sc in last 4 sts

*Row 19 (WS)* – turn, ch 1, sc into next 33 sts

Row 20 (RS) – turn, ch 1, sc in 3 sts, sc3tog in 3 sts, sc in 4 sts, sc3tog in 3 sts, sc in 7 sts, sc3tog in 3 sts, sc in 4 sts, sc3tog in 3 sts, sc in 4 sts, sc3tog in 3 sts, sc in last 3 sts

Row 21 (WS) – turn, ch 1, sc into next 25 sts





Final Neck Edge Row 22 (RS) – turn, ch 1, sc into next 25 sts



**Button Loop** Ch 4, sc into base of 1<sup>st</sup> ch

# **Back Opening Edge**Note – work sc edge stitches down the Bodice Back Right

edge and then back up the Bodice Back Left edge.

sc into 11 row edge sts, sc into gap, turn, sc into 11 row edge sts



Fasten of leaving a long tail to sew the button on with.



**Finishing** 

Use the long neck edge tail to sew on the button opposite the button loop. Sew in the two MC tails

Sew in the 6 CC tails. Lightly block the skirt to flatten the heart pattern stripes.

#### **Head Band**




Using MC crochet 35 ch sts. Join in the round with a slip st taking care not to twist the chain.



Rnd 1 – ch 1, sc into next 35 sts, sl st into  $1^{st}$  ch st to complete the round. Cut yarn leaving a short tail, sew two ends in.

#### **Heart for Head Band**







Rnd 1 – With CC1 crochet 7 ch sts, skip 2 sts, sl st in last 5 sts.



Rnd 2 – skip 2 sts, sc, hdc, dc, in next 3 sts, work 4 tr in end loop, ch 4, sl st into loop, ch 4, work 4 tr in end loop, then dc, hdc, sc in remaining sts.



*Note* – stitches should mirror each other to create a heart shape. See photographs at end of pattern.

Cut yarn leaving a short tail. Sew heart to head band over join, sew in tails.

Make a ch of required number of sts. Insert hook in first ch, yo, draw yarn through st and loop on hook.



#### Slip Stitch


Step 1: Insert hook in next st.



Step 2: Yo, draw yarn through st and loop on hook.



Step 3: Rep from Step 1 for required number of sts.



### Single Crochet (sc)

Step 1: Insert hook in second ch from hook.



Step 2: Yo. draw varn through st, yo, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook (1 sc).



Step 3: Insert hook in next st.



Step 4: Rep from Step 2 for required number of sts.


#### Picot

Picot can be made in different ways. Always refer to the directions at the beg of pat.

Step 1: Ch 3, or required number of sts.



Step 2: Insert hook in third ch and through back loop of st (pictured here as sc), yo, draw yarn through st and 2 loops on



Step 3: One picot made.



#### Reverse sc

Step 1: With right side facing, insert hook in next st to the right.




Step 2: Yo, draw yarn through



Step 3: Yo, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook (1 reverse sc).



Step 4: Rep from Step 1 for required number of sts.



#### Half Double Crochet (hdc)

Step 1: Yo, insert hook in fourth ch from hook.



Step 2: Yo, draw yarn through st, yo, draw through 3 loops on hook (1 hdc).



Step 3: Yo, insert hook in next st, rep from Step 2 for required number of sts.



#### Double Crochet (dc)

Step 1: Yo, insert hook in fifth ch from hook.



Step 2: Yo, draw yarn through st, yo, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook.



Step 3: Yo, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook (1 dc).



Step 4: Yo, insert hook in next st, rep from Step 2 for required number of sts






#### Back Post dc (BP dc)

Step 1: Yo, insert hook from front to back bet the posts of first and second dc, then to front again, bet the posts of second and third dc (hook is now positioned horizontally in back of dc to be worked).



**Step 2:** Yo, draw loop through, (yo, draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

#### Treble Crochet (tr)

Step 1: Yo (twice), insert hook in sixth ch from hook.



Step 2: Yo, draw yarn through st, • yo, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook •, rep from • to • once.



Step 3: Yo, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook (1 tr).



**Step 4:** Yo (twice), insert hook in next st, rep from Step 2 for required number of sts.





#### Treble Treble Crochet (trtr)


Step 1: Yo (4 times), insert hook in eighth ch from hook.



Step 2: Yo, draw yarn through st, • yo, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook •, rep from • to • 4 times (1 trtr).



**Step 3:** Yo (4 times), insert hook in next st, rep from Step 2 for required number of sts.



#### **Puff Stitch**

A cluster of sts in same st (shown here for 3 dc).

Step 1: Yo, insert hook in st, yo, draw yarn through st, yo, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook.



**Step 2:** Rep Step 1 (twice). Yo, draw yarn through 4 loops on hook.



Step 3: 1 puff stitch made.





### Front Post dc (FP dc)

Step 1: Yo, insert hook from back to front bet the posts of first and second dc, then to back again, bet the posts of second and third dc (hook is now positioned horizontally in front of dc to be worked).



Step 2: Yo, draw loop through, (yo, draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.





#### Double Treble Crochet(dtr)

Step 1: Yo (3 times), insert hook in seventh ch from hook.



Step 2: Yo, draw yarn through st, • yo, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook •, rep from • to • 3 times (1 dtr).



Step 3: Yo (3 times), insert hook in next st, rep from Step 2 for required number of sts.






#### Cluster

A required number of sts (shown here for 4 dc) half closed and joined tog.

Step 1: • Yo, insert hook in next st, yo, draw yarn through st, yo, draw through 2 loops on hook •, rep from • to • 3 times.



Step 2: Yo, draw yarn through 5 loops on hook.



Step 3: 1 cluster of 4 dc made.



#### Popcorn (pop)

A required number of sts (shown here for 5 dc) worked in same st and joined tog as shown.

To puff on front of work: Work 5 dc in same st, drop loop from hook, insert hook from front to back in top of first dc of group, pull dropped loop through st.



To puff on back of work: Work 5 dc in same st, drop loop from hook, insert hook from back to front in top of first dc of group, pull dropped loop through st.
